This exclusive event will be held in Tateuchi Hall at the Community School of Music and Arts, located at 230 San Antonio Circle in Mountain View. This concert is free and open to the public. Seating is limited; please arrive early. Doors open at 6:00pm.

The Music at Tateuchi Preview Concert will feature violinist Florin Parvulescu (San Francisco Symphony; Music at Tateuchi Artistic Director), as well as collaborative pianist Nicholas Dold (Opera San Jose) and collaborative pianist Samantha Cho (SF Conservatory of Music). Also performing will be Music at Tateuchi 2017 alumni Daniel Tan (piano) and Catherine Choi (cello), along with Music at Tateuchi 2018 participant Paul Garofalo (piano).

The second annual Music at Tateuchi workshop will be held at CSMA in July. Music at Tateuchi is a two-week, intensive summer program offering high level training to intermediate and advanced string players and pianists that are selected by video audition. Under members of the San Francisco Symphony and distinguished guest artists, students participate in daily master classes, recitals, chamber music and small group coaching. Music at Tateuchi provides ample opportunities to perform in public, honing professionalism, developing leadership skills and self-confidence.

CSMA, a non-profit center for arts education, provides unique music and visual arts programming and events for audiences of all ages and backgrounds. In keeping with CSMA's mission to engage the community with Arts4All, all concerts are free and open to the public.
