The Community School of Music and Arts Presents Yvette Young, May 20

MOUNTAIN VIEW, CA – The Community School of Music and Arts (CSMA) in Mountain View presents a free concert with Yvette Young on Sunday, May 20 at 2:00pm. The performance will be held in Tateuchi Hall at the Community School of Music and Arts, located at 230 San Antonio Circle in Mountain View. This concert is free and open to the public. Seating is limited; please arrive early. Doors open at 1:30pm.

Guitarist Yvette Young is one of the top young rising stars in the Bay Area music scene. Her innovative guitar technique has been compared to luminaries such as Stanley Jordan, Allan Holdsworth and Robert Fripp. A singer, songwriter and multi-instrumentalist, Yvette has recorded and performed with guitar, violin, piano, harp and banjo. She has released three EPs, *Acoustics EP* (2014), *Yvette Young/Natalie Evans* split EP (2015) and *Acoustics EP 2* (2017). Her sound has been described as dream pop, ethereal, folk and math rock. She is currently the front-woman of math rock band Covet.
