### **The Community School of Music and Arts Presents Music at Tateuchi Faculty and Student Concerts, July 2018**

MOUNTAIN VIEW, CA – The Community School of Music and Arts (CSMA) in Mountain View presents a series of concerts to showcase the faculty and students of the Music at Tateuchi summer program. The Music at Tateuchi faculty concerts will be held on Thursday, July 12 at 7:30pm and Thursday, July 19 at 7:30pm. The Music at Tateuchi student concerts will be held on Saturday, July 14 at 2:00pm and Saturday, July 21 at 2:00pm. All concerts will be held in Tateuchi Hall at the Community School of Music and Arts, located at 230 San Antonio Circle in Mountain View. All concerts are free and open to the public. Seating is limited; please arrive early. Doors open at 30 minutes prior to each event.

The Music at Tateuchi faculty includes members of the San Francisco Symphony and distinguished guest artists. The faculty concerts present a unique opportunity to see professional musicians at the top of their field in an intimate local concert hall. Scheduled performers for each concert will be announced. Music at Tateuchi faculty members include Florin Parvulescu (Violin, San Francisco Symphony), Helen Kim (Associate Principal 2nd Violin, San Francisco Symphony), Eric Sung (Principal Cello, San Francisco Ballet), Samantha Cho (Collaborative Pianist, San Francisco Conservatory of Music), Nicholas Dold (Collaborative Pianist, Opera San Jose), Aaron Janse (Violin/Viola, Minnesota Orchestra), Ayke Agus (Collaborative Pianist), David Kim (Viola) and guest artist Brinton Averil Smith (Principal Cello, Houston Symphony).

The second annual Music at Tateuchi workshop will be held at CSMA from July 9-21. Music at Tateuchi is a two-week, intensive summer program offering high level training to intermediate and advanced string players and pianists that are selected by video audition. Under members of the San Francisco Symphony and distinguished guest artists, students participate in daily master classes, recitals, chamber music and small group coaching. Music at Tateuchi provides ample opportunities for students to perform in public, honing professionalism, developing leadership skills and self-confidence. Launched in 2017, the program is made possible through a collaboration between the San Francisco Institute for Classical Music Performance (SFI) and CSMA.
