CSMA Financial Aid Policy

In keeping with our commitment to Arts for All, CSMA offers financial aid in the form of Tuition Assistance (TA). Financial aid may be applied to private lessons, classes, camps, workshops or art clubs.

Financial aid awards are valid through two sequential semesters.

Financial aid can be used for up to two summer camp sessions for each student. It cannot be used for more than two sessions.

Available funds are determined at the beginning of each fiscal year and are distributed on a sliding scale. In keeping with Federal Assistance guidelines, the percentage of tuition assistance awarded to each family is based on income level and number of dependents. All financial aid must be approved before students can be assigned to a private lesson teacher or enrolled in a class/camp/workshop. (Enrollment deadlines are listed in the CSMA course catalog and online.)

To be eligible for tuition assistance, parents or legal guardians must provide the following:

Option 1

- 1. Federal tax return (1st page only)
- 2. W2 forms documenting all income on tax return
- 3. Previous 2 months pay stubs for all wage earners in the family

Option 2

Free or reduced school lunch letter

Option 3

Housing/Section 8 voucher

Attendance Policy for Students Receiving Financial Aid

We require that students attend all of their classes/lessons (with the exception of illness) in order to maintain their financial aid award. Parents will be asked to certify that their child attended all lessons, or to note exceptions, at the end of the semester. An excellent attendance record will be required to register for the following semester.
